What's the Mission and What Does That Mean Today?

Growing as Communities of Mission

To grow as Communities of Mission within the co-mission of Jesus, in the power of the Holy Spirit, we would be wise to take notice of what's producing 'fruit' in parishes that have intentionally set out on a mission-focused path. This encompasses leadership and parish culture, parishioners growing as disciples rather than consumers, calling forth gifts not filling 'job gaps', knowing the essential Good News and being able to authentically communicate it.

About the Keynote Speakers

Fr Richard Rosse PP and Ann O'Brien, Parish Evangelisation Coordinator, are from Caroline Springs Parish, western Melbourne. They will share their insights and lived experience creating a community of belonging and growing as community of mission.

Caroline Springs Parish (St Catherine of Siena) stands out for its intentional, community-driven approach to missionary discipleship. Built in a rapidly expanding demographic hub in Melbourne's west, the parish has carefully cultivated a vibrant, family-centric culture that actively engages its culturally diverse and young population.
